SINQ	seer.cancer.gov	On this website look for the heading Data Collection Tools, and under it you will find SEER Inquiry System (SINQ). You may type in a subject word and search for answers on that topic. The system is maintained in a different way than the COC's I&R. Rather than letting people submit questions directly, the questions are screened at SEER and some of them ultimately get published in SINQ.
