


## FLccSC Learning Management System



### What is FLccSC?

FLccSC is a cancer surveillance community educational collaboration. FLccSC is a web-based portal which allows Central Cancer Registries (CCR) to customize a fully functioning state-specific Learning Management System (LMS).

### Overview of the State-Specific Learning Management System

The Florida Cancer Data System and the South Carolina Central Cancer Registry developed FLccSC collaboratively. The initial development was funded by the respective State Departments of Health and the CDC/NPCR.

- FLccSC is a fully functioning LMS that allows each CCR the ability to develop and maintain their own state-specific educational platform using original content or content made available by other states.
- Each CCR LMS is a stand-alone customized platform, including the CCR logos and branding.
- Each CCR has two customized URL's for their registry. The CCR site administrator manages the CCR specific site through a web-based back end, whereas the students interact with the web-based LMS front end.
- Each CCR site administrator can access the full functionality of their FLccSC LMS enabling them to manage and customize the home page, educational modules/quizzes (videos, PDFs) and management reports.
- FLccSC is scalable to allow a CCR to deploy as many educational modules as desired.
- FLccSC allows educational material to be shared between and among CCRs at the e-Administrator's discretion.
- Students access FLccSC from a link on each states CCR web-site. Once registered, the student will only see the LMS pages and content from their respective CCR. Once the student successfully completes an educational module, they will receive a Certificate of Completion including CEU where applicable.
- FLccSC is a web-based educational collaborative LMS that is available 24/7. It is cost efficient in that the students do not have to travel to a central training site or purchase training materials.
- FLccSC support includes access to a Help Desk for technical support and tutorials as a menu item on both the student site (frontend) and the e\_Administration site (backend). The step by step tutorials details how to develop and maintain the CCR FLccSC site and educational content.

The Fundamental Learning Collaborative for the Cancer Surveillance Community (FLccSC) learning management system (LMS) was developed to provide cancer surveillance professionals in Florida a web-based educational platform. Courses are designed for students of all experience/skill levels. There are courses and modules for those that are new to the cancer surveillance field and continuing education courses for the seasoned professional.

- The FCDS Abstractor Code Test is one of the modules in FLccSC.

FLccSC was developed collaboratively by the Florida Cancer Data System and the South Carolina Central Cancer Registry. Funding for the initial development was from the State of Florida Department of Health, the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention/National Program of Cancer Registries.

**Collaborative eLearning**

The Florida Cancer Data System's FCDS online training and continuing education courses enable the user to learn the fundamentals of cancer abstracting and the latest cancer registration and surveillance methodology at their own pace.

Additionally, FLccSC is a community of cancer surveillance professional organizations. Therefore, the student may choose from modules designed by FCDS and modules designed and shared by other Central Cancer Registries.

FCDS is committed to offering comprehensive online training and continuing education to individuals in Florida's cancer registration and surveillance community. Every time you complete a course, you earn a certificate of completion making your skill set and resume stronger.
