



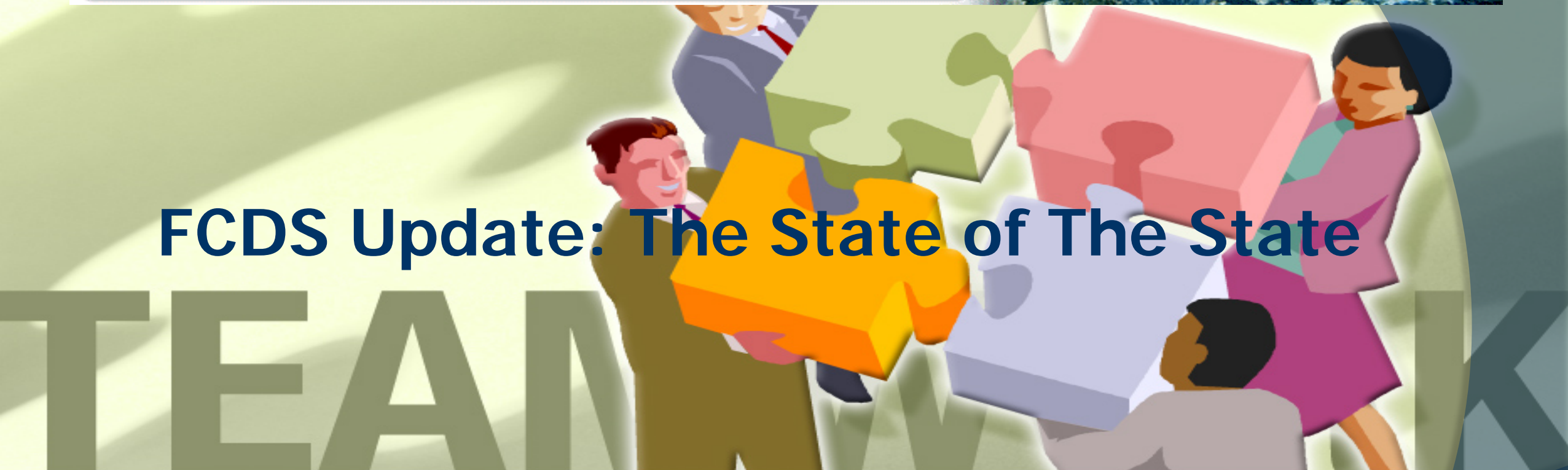

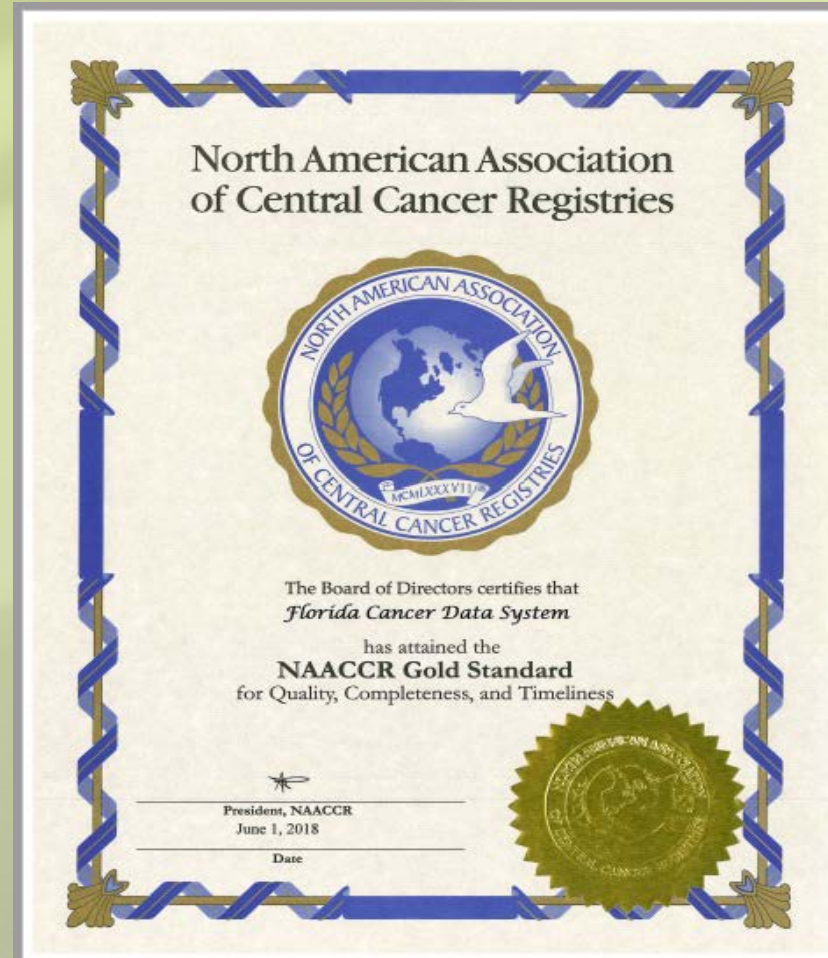

FLORIDA CANCER DATA SYSTEM

Provides critical and high-quality data that are included in the official federal statistics on cancer incidence and mortality, United States Cancer Statistics (USCS). USCS data are used to assess the cancer burden, inform and evaluate prevention efforts, and address disparities. USCS is produced annually by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the National Cancer Institute (NCI).

Update: FLccSC LMS



- Joint Project between Florida and South Carolina CCRs
- NEW: Funding Support by CDC/NPCR through 1/31/2021
- Now Truly a National Collaborative
 - 26 State Central Cancer Registries registered
 - CDC/NPCR State Education Training Coordinators (2 students/CCR)
 - Over ~1,400 active students registered (Florida - 1,012 Students)
 - Over ~3,500 enrolled courses
 - 87 Courses have been developed (47 by Florida)
- Expands available education
 - States to share education developed (Florida sharing 11 courses)
 - State without educators can still get education for their reporters

Florida Cancer Screening System - Pilot

- Five Year CDC/NPCR Special Project started July 2017
- Focus on Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening
- Goal: Complete a feasibility study of developing population based screening registry
- Pilot
 - Collaborating with FBCCEDP
 - Working with Mammography Centers/GYN in Hillsborough County
 - Ultimately expand to Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach County



Florida Cancer Screening System - Pilot

- Multi-Tiered Approach to Data Collection
 - Collect claims filter ICD10, CPT & HCPCS for screening
 - Evaluate interfaces to Electronic Health Record
 - Develop customized data dictionary based on ability to collect
- Link data with the FCDS registry to determine outcomes
- End result will be to define the feasibility and methods to collect screening data at a population level in Florida



Florida Cancer Screening System - Pilot

Florida Cancer Data System Registry

1. WHAT IS FCSS?

- *Florida Cancer Screening System is a surveillance system for collection of screening information on breast & cervical cancer.*
- *Years 1-2 will focus on Hillsborough County. Years 3-5 will expand to Miami-Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach counties.*
- *FCSS will collaborate with the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention National Program of Cancer Registries & Florida Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program.*

2. PURPOSE OF FCSS

- *Develop a population-based screening registry gathering age appropriate screening data throughout the state, including linking FL Breast and Cervical Screening Data to the Florida Cancer Data System.*
- *As more cancer patients become cancer survivors, more information is needed by the medical community to improve quality of life for cancer survivors.*

3. INFORMATION NEEDED FROM PROVIDERS

- *2 methods will be used to collect screening information.*
- *Claims- Data from medical claims using ICD-9, ICD-10, CPT, & HCPCS converted into ICD-O-3/FORDS codes and cross matched against FCDS data.*
- *EHR- FCDS will select an Electronic Health Records vendor that works closely with gynecologists & mammography centers to collect and submit data.*

4. BENEFITS TO PROVIDERS

- *No fees to participate or monetary gains.*
- *Will allow providers to better understand the development of cancer enabling better care to patients.*
- *Educational opportunities and information in relation to cancer and health outcomes will be available post data collection.*
- *Participation from the medical community is imperative in FCSS efforts to collect and disseminate screenable cancer data.*

5. GOALS OF FCSS

- *The overall goal is to gather screening data for the state of Florida to hopefully improve health outcomes & quality of life for our residents.*
- *Development of informed research.*
- *Development of intervention and screening programs.*
- *Development of state-specific policies and strategies to improve access and quality of care.*

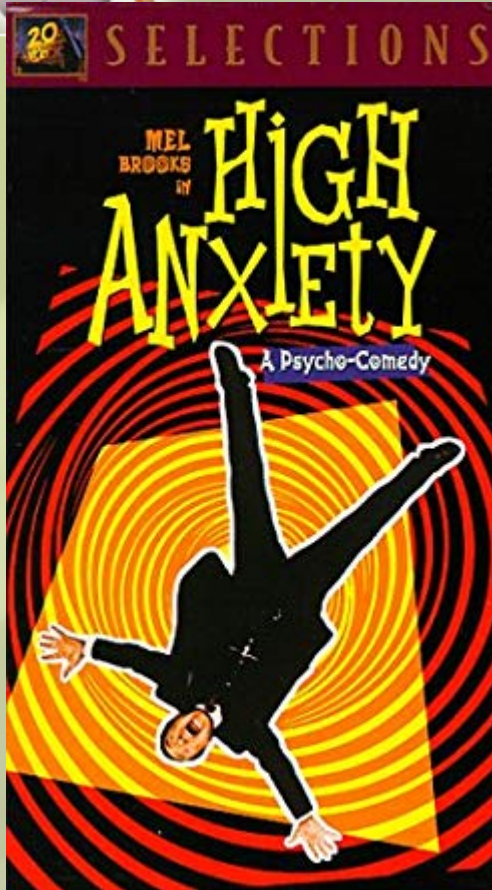
6. FUTURE ENDEAVORS

- *Include all screenable cancers.*





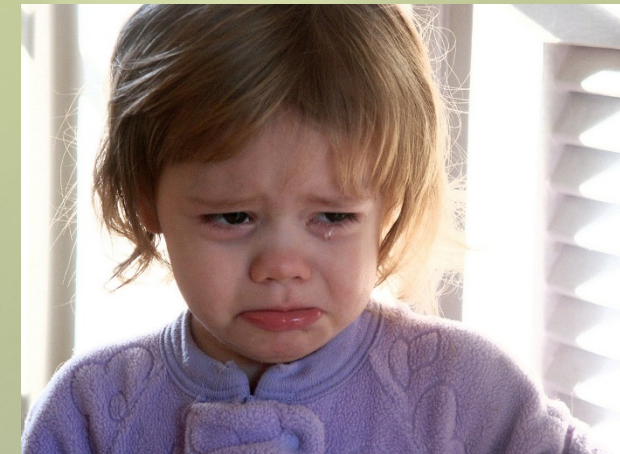

New for Diagnosis Year 2018

- ICDO3 Enhancements
- SEER Summary Stage 2018
- 8th Edition TNM (**NOT Required by the FCDS**)
- Three New Grade Data Items
- New Radiation Modality data items
 - FCDS only requires Phase I
- New Site Specific Data Items (SSDI)
 - FCDS only requires nine SSDI from eight schemas



New for Diagnosis Year 2018

- New Multiple Primary and Histology Coding Rules
- Updates to Hematopoietic Multiple Primary Rules
- New Grade Coding Instructions and Tables
- New Site-Specific Data Items Manual
- New COC STORE Manual



FCDS – Updates for Diagnosis Year 2018

- Starting 8/1/2019
 - EDITS Metafile 18D Release
 - V16 Batch Uploads will no longer be available
 - Diagnosis Date will no longer permit unknown dates
- Working with facilities to reduce the number of unknown SSN
- Working with standard setters
 - To ensure **NO CHANGES UNTIL 2021**
 - So far this has been a struggle but continue trying



FCDS – Updates for Diagnosis Year 2018

Deadline Extended to 3/31/2020

No Plans for Extension

Submit regularly and often

Communicate with Your Field Coordinator



FCDS – Diagnosis Year 2019???

- No changes in requirements for Diagnosis Year 2019
- NPCR has stated no changes until calendar year 2021
- FCDS will accept 2019 data once 2018 is certified complete
- Deadline for 2019
 - To Be Determined
 - Hope to get back on normal reporting timeline as soon as possible
