Impact:

- Lack of coordination among cancer surveillance community
- Workforce concerns
- Insufficient resources
- Ever increasing expectations
- Concern about quality data
- Delays software, edits, training, delay data collection

Response:

- All required changes are important
- NO changes in data collection in 2020
- Postpone data changes until 2021

CDC Strategies to Improve Cancer Data and Reporting

Implement ePath/biomarker reporting from laboratories Implement e-reporting from Physician EHRs Explore use of IHE/HL7 FHIR Structured Data Capture Develop software to process HL7 2.x and HL7 CDA Natural Language Processing Web Service

Survivorship, Treatment, Access, and Research Act of 2018 (STAR)



Congress has authorized CDC to:

- 1. Identify, recruit, and train potential sources for reporting cases.
- 2. Develop practices to ensure early inclusion of cases in State cancer registries through electronic reporting.
- 3. Collect and submit de-identified data to CDC for inclusion in a national database.
- 4. Improve State cancer registries and the database, as appropriate, including to support the early inclusion of PAYAC cases

Cancer Data Modernization

- Improving our cancer registry system's ability to capture electronic pathology reports for ALL cancers INCLUDING pediatric cancers
- Continue working with the states to improve timeliness and completeness of these cases within 30 days
- Strengthen relationships with key partners such as NCI and the Children's Oncology Group hospitals
