### Non-Compliant Hospitals 2022 Cases

- 103 hospitals have not completed reporting the number of cases expected
- 60 hospitals are less than 75% complete
- Hospitals will be reported to DOH by the end of September 2023
- You Must Certify Complete for 2022


### Radiation Treatment Facilities Reporting Options

**Option 1: Proactive Case Reporting** 

Option 2: Two-step process to lessen the burden due to limited resources and case count

- 1. Casefinding
  - Facility must create a file of all patient encounters that contain a reportable ICD10 code
    - 12 data items for each patient
  - Upload file to FCDS via FCDS IDEA
  - FCDS then links these encounters with the FCDS database after the Annual Reporting Deadline
- 2. Follow Back unmatched patients to the Radiation Treatment facility
  - Must submit a full cancer case abstract for missed cases
  - Must account for the non reportable cases



323 labs are fully integrated into FCDS operations

Close to 17 million path reports in the FCDS database

Linked cases are used in QC, CAPIS, Consolidated FB



## 2021 Consolidated Follow Back

49,740 records were identified for follow back

- Hospitals, Non-hospitals, and Ambulatory Surgery
- Most of them will be not reportable cases
- Approximately 10,000 cases will be reportable

Notices were emailed to hospitals and ambulatory surgery centers on May 1, 2023

#### **Deadline is September 1, 2023**

## 2021 Consolidated Follow Back

- For any missed case
  - Assign Disposition Code 01
  - Accession # and Sequence #
- Disposition Code 01 records (missed cases) must be electronically reported to FCDS within 30 days of assigning the Disposition Code.
- After the 30 days, the record(s) will be placed back in the queue and marked as incomplete.

Death Certificate with a cancer as the cause of death

- Match with a pathology record
- Limited information
- Visually review these matches
  - Pathology reports
- Experienced CTR
- Reportable vs. Not reportable
- 2021 Death Certificates
  - 4,151 records with a cancer as the cause of death
  - 1,364 matched and need visual review



June 30	Annual Reporting Deadline	All cases from previous calendar year must be reported to FCDS on or before June 30 <sup>th</sup> each year			
September 1	Consolidated Follow-Back Deadline	All unmatched cases from the combined AHCA and Vital Records Death Match must be resolved by September 1 <sup>st</sup> .			
Varies	FAPTP Follow-Back Deadline	All unmatched cases from FAPTP must be resolved each year
