V22 XML and V23 XML Data Submission

FCDS will allow data uploads in V22 XML in conjunction with V23 XML. Data uploads in V22 XML will be allowed until October 31, 2023, and for cases diagnosed on or before 2022.

31 Oct. 2023

1 Nov. 2023

Effective November 1, 2023, all data uploads will need to be using V23 XML only.

- Codes starting with A
- Codes starting with B
- Surgery of Primary Site codes are site specific and may differ based on diagnosis year
 - Be sure to use the appropriate manual based on diagnosis year

- Data Item # 3960- Histologic Subtype
- Only for the Appendix
- Schema id 09190

4	Other terminology coded to 8480

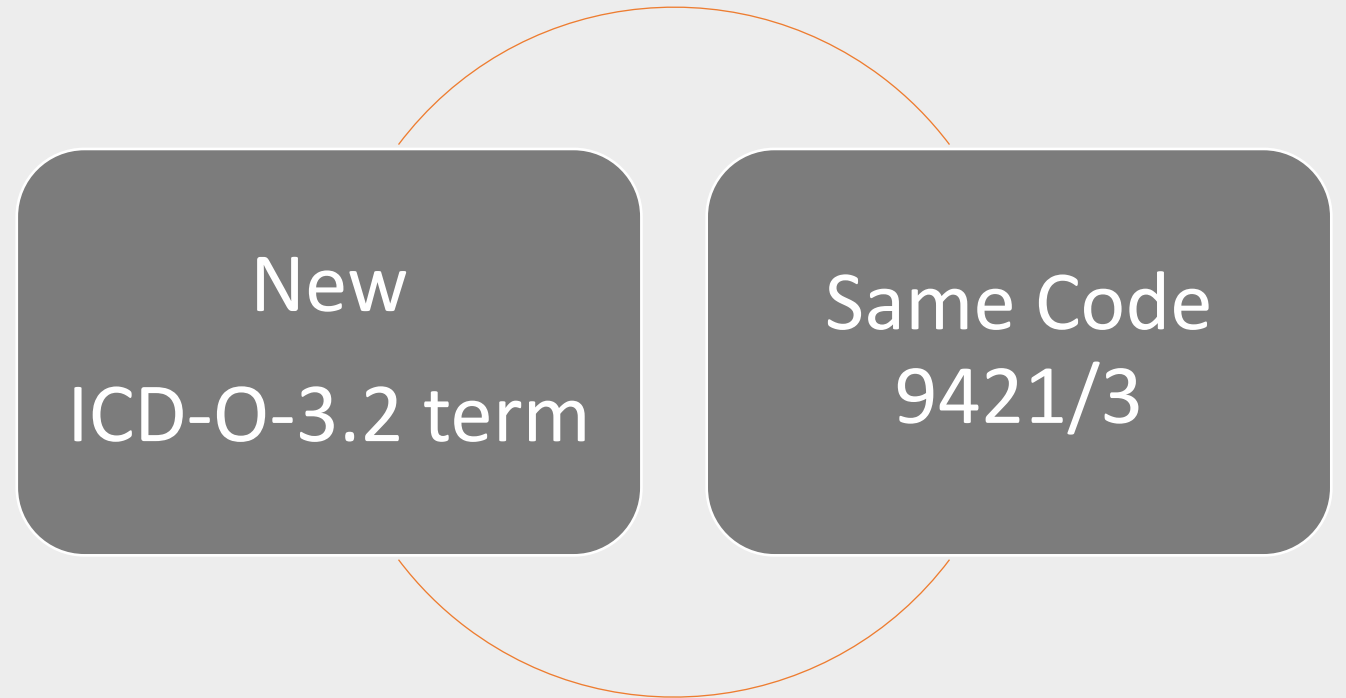

- 8086 Squamous cell carcinoma, HPV-independent C51.9; C52.9; C53.X_
- 8483 Adenocarcinoma, HPV-associated
- 8484 Adenocarcinoma, HPV-independent, NOS
- 8482 Adenocarcinoma, HPV-independent, gastric type
- 8310 Adenocarcinoma, HPV-independent, clear cell type
- 9110 Adenocarcinoma, HPV-independent, mesonephric type C53.X; C56.9

Solid Tumor Rules Evolution

2007 Site Specific Multiple Primary and Histology Rules



2018 Solid Tumor Rules



In 2021, the Cutaneous Melanoma MP/H were revised and become part of the Solid Tumor Rules



Starting in 2022, the 2018 Solid Tumor Rules are now simply called Solid Tumor Rules



In 2023, still being called Solid Tumor Rules

Solid Tumor Rules 2023 Updates

CNS- New instructions were added for Pilocytic Astrocytoma to the malignant and non-malignant CNS rules.

Breast- Clarifications to Rule M10 and the applicable histology rules for coding lobular and ductal tumors were added; “Assign behavior code /3 even when an in-situ histology is mixed with an invasive. This aligns with ICD-O-3.2 and was vetted with specialty matter experts.”

Prostate- New Rule M4- Abstract multiple primaries when the patient has a subsequent small cell carcinoma 8041 of the prostate more than 1 year following a diagnosis of acinar adenocarcinoma and/or subtype/variant of acinar adenocarcinoma of prostate (Table 3).

Solid Tumor Rules 2023 Updates

Head & Neck- Table 9 was redesigned;

New timing rule: Abstract multiple primaries when the patient has a subsequent tumor after being clinically disease-free for greater than five years after the original diagnosis or last recurrence;

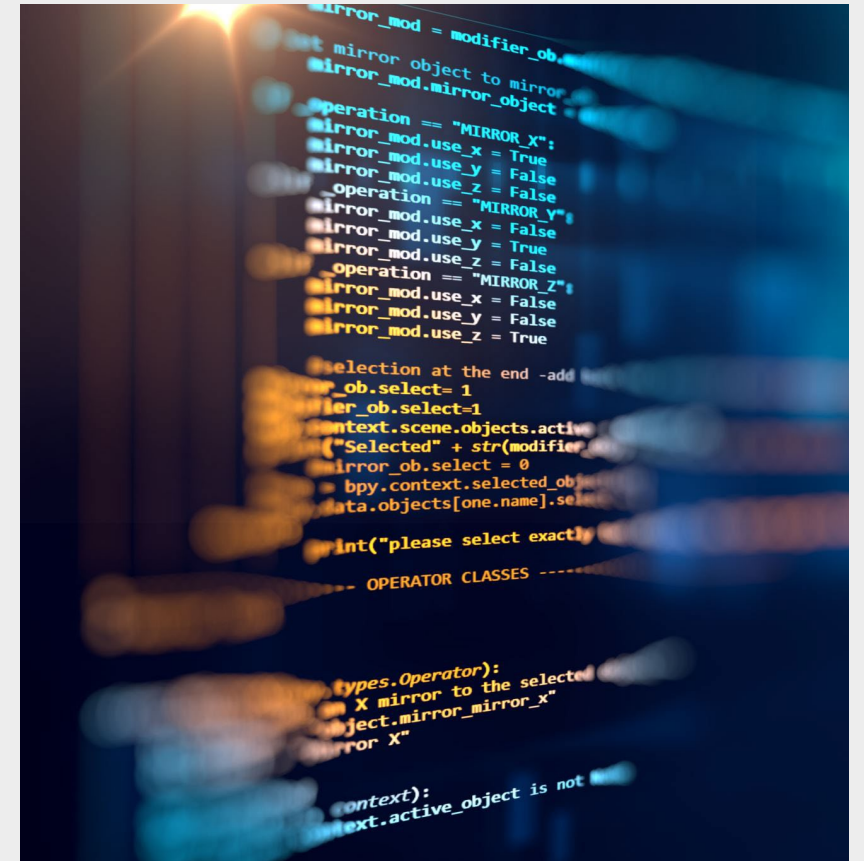
C754 and C755 added to the H&N module

Other Sites- Completely revised. Same format, histology coding requirements and timing instructions as the current solid tumor rules for the site-specific modules.

New Rule M8- Abstract multiple primaries when separate/non-contiguous tumors are anaplastic carcinoma and any other histologies in the thyroid. Note: This rule does not apply to multiple tumors that are anaplastic carcinoma and undifferentiated carcinoma.

- The metafile and associated files include all new and revised standard and Florida-specific edits. These are the three ancillary excel files also posted:
 - FCDS v23B Change Spreadsheet
 - FCDS New Error Messages v22b
 - FCDS Metafile v23B Error Messages Report
- Data submitted in V23 XML must use the FCDS EDITSv23B metafile (or most current)
