FCDS is a Florida Statewide Cancer Registry in 100% of the Florida Department of Health's jurisdiction under the Surveillance Component of the National Cancer Center (NCCR) of the National Program of Cancer Registries (NPCR). FCDS has been collecting population-wide cancer data since 1988.

In October 2010, the Florida Cancer Data System became an official member of the National Program of Cancer Registries (NPCR) through the program of the CDC's National Cancer Center (NCCR). 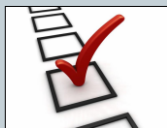
