### NPCR CNS CODING GUIDELINES 2007

NPCR conducted a quality control review of all CNS data for 2004 (both malignant and non-malignant) with the first non-malignant Central Nervous System cases received in the 2007 call for data. The review identified the need for additional training regarding the coding of primary site and histology for both malignant and non-malignant CNS tumors. You may find the NPCR CNS coding guidelines on the FCDS website <http://fcds.med.miami.edu/> under Downloads, Data Acquisition Manual. The majority of the coding discrepancies found in the review were meningiomas (Histologic Type ICD-O-3 9530) coded to brain rather than meninges. All meningiomas regardless of behavior must be coded to C70.0-C70.9 unless directed otherwise by a pathologist. All meningiomas reported to FCDS not coded to meninges will fail the edit check. These cases will require an edit override.

### 2005 Cancer Case Admissions

#### Criteria

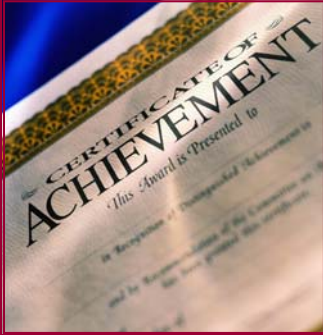
1. Timeliness -All deadlines met with respect to 2005 cancer case admissions
  - 2005 Annual Caseload Submission Deadline– June 30, 2006
  - 2005 Death Certificate Notification Deadline– September 21, 2007
  - 2005 AHCA Audit Deadline - April 30, 2007
  - No more than 5% (or 35 cases, whichever number is greater) of the 2005 cancer case admissions reported to FCDS within 2 months (60 Days) following the June 30, 2006 deadline (Late reporting of 2005 cancer case admissions)
2. Completeness– All cases reported to FCDS
  - No more than 10% of the 2005 cancer case admissions reported to FCDS within 12 months following the June 30, 2006 reporting deadline. (Due to delinquent 2005 case reporting, missed cases found on Death Certificate Notification, or missed cases found on AHCA Completeness Audit)

# Deadlines & Reminders

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## **2006 CANCER CASE REPORTING BY THE RADIATION THERAPY CENTERS**

FCDS matched the 2006 cancer records identified by the radiation therapy facilities with the FCDS database in November 2007. The lists of records that did not match with a FCDS case have been mailed to the facilities for review. The radiation therapy facilities only receive notification for cases that have never been reported to FCDS.

The list of unmatched cancer records must be reviewed to determine whether or not each of the cases must be abstracted and submitted to FCDS. All data submitted to FCDS must be via the encrypted Internet transmission, FCDS IDEA. For further information, visit the FCDS website at <http://fcds.med.miami.edu/>. If the case does not meet the FCDS reporting criteria, the appropriate Disposition Code must be documented on the form and returned to FCDS. If after reviewing all the cases on the RT Unmatched Cancer Records Request 2006 list, the facility has fewer than 35 reportable cases, only copies of patient records (Face sheet, Summary, History & Physical, Operative Reports, Consultation Reports, Pathology Reports, Radiology Reports, Laboratory Reports and all other pertinent reports, if available) must be mailed to FCDS for each of the cases on the list.

**If submitting full cancer abstracts, the deadline is March 31, 2008.**

**If submitting copies of patient medical records, the deadline is January 31, 2008.**
